
In the lead up to graduation, we work hard to ensure that we give our students as many auditions and opportunities as we possibly can to try to line up work for them after their graduation.





We are exceptionally proud of our students, not just because of their incredible talent in the performing arts, but also because of their supportive, kind and confident natures that we carefully nurture under our care.

In the second year of training, we are proud to offer not one, but two teacher qualification options to our students. Students are able to take teachers examinations in Street Dance following the UDO syllabus and/or Acting with the London College of Music. We are proud to boast a 100% pass rate in these exams, giving our students the opportunity to teach either alongside their training, or indeed to take teaching as a career when they graduate. There is also the option to study teaching singing with the LCM. With our huge part time theatre school here at the academy, there is no shortage of opportunities to get teaching experience.

Training in Musical Theatre and particularly with our emphasis on acting for TV and Film, our students are continually encouraged to communication skills that they can take with

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


