To us, you're an individual, a person. Our support continues through your three years of training and beyond when you move into the full-time profession.



D&B School of Performing Arts has always welcomed students from all walks of life, with different areas of expertise and backgrounds in training.



Fulfill your Potential



This can be anything from filming a few days on a feature film, or being involved in prestigious workshops for musical theatre. We've had students appearing in television dramas, commercials and live TV performances.




In the lead up to graduation, we work hard to ensure that we give our students as many auditions and opportunities as we possibly can to try to line up work for them after their graduation.

We believe you should be able to pursue a career in the performing arts regardless of your background.


We are equally excited by a spark of raw talent as we are by someone with years of previous training. We are confident that our outstanding tuition and care will get you where you want to be.


